Dear brothers and sisters

During this coming week, on the 8 December, we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of Our Lady.

The Angel Gabriel, as the Gospel tells us, greeted her as 'full of grace'. The Catechism takes up this fact, stating that: "in order for Mary to be able to give the free assent of her faith, to the announcement of her vocation, it was necessary that she be wholly borne by God's grace." It is for this reason that, through God's grace and the merits of her Son, she was – as Pope Pius IX proclaimed – "preserved immune from all stain of original sin."

All we believe about our Blessed Mother points us to her Son. Her immaculate conception prepared her for her singular role in God's plan as the mother of our Saviour, whose birth we are soon to celebrate.

In a Diocese where so many travel to Lourdes each year, we might also recall Our Lady's words to Bernadette, for in the Grotto at Lourdes our Blessed Mother referred to herself as the 'Immaculate Conception'. In this way, Mary stands with us directing us to her Son.

Let us ask Mary – she who is 'full of grace' – to pray with us and for us, for our intentions, for all whom we hold dear, for our troubled world and for that peace that is the gift of her Son.
