### Bishop Richard reflects on the permanent diaconate:

Dear brothers and sisters,

On Friday of this week, those of our Diocese in formation for the Permanent Diaconate gathered at the Shrine of our Lady of Consolation in West Grinstead. This gathering takes place each year at about this time, and at Vespers those moving from their year of initial formation into the more formal 3-year programme of study are admitted for Candidacy for Orders.

At the Mass which follows, our students - depending on their stage of formation - receive the ministries of Lector and Acolyte. While in some ways a gentle celebration, it is a significant moment in the journeys of our students, their families, and the parish communities who support them in their continuing discernment and study.

Please pray for our students for the Permanent Diaconate; Patrick Bergin, Claude Chetta and Mathew Thomas, all admitted to Candidacy. Mike Dean who receives the Ministry of Lector, and Ben Williams and Simon Tierney who receive the Ministry of Acolyte. Please pray also for an increase in the numbers responding to the call to diaconal ministry in the life of the Diocese.

The vocation of the deacon lies most especially in the Ministry of Word, and in charity. Word and charity are clearly connected, for charity flows from the Word and is carried out in a myriad of ways.

As we look to the future of our Diocese, the ministry of our deacons will develop even further; they will be called to greater responsibilities in the years ahead as has been the case at other times in the history of the Church. This year, Graham Palmer joins our other diaconate students as he embarks on his initial year of formation. May he be joined by many others in the coming years
