## A message from Bishop Richard on the Second Sunday of Advent

In this Sunday's Gospel John the Baptist arrives on the scene, calling people to repentance. The Gospel makes a direct reference to the writings of the prophet Isaiah, that we hear in the first reading today.

Isaiah speaks of the consolation that the people will find in God, and he uses the image of the shepherd caring for the sheep. Even in Isaiah, the message is clear that the prophet will point the way to the God who comes – and, as we look back on these prophecies through the eyes of our Christian faith, our minds go straight to the Good Shepherd, Jesus – the Word made Flesh. True consolation is found only in Him, for in Him is found forgiveness and life.

Listening to the voice of John the Baptist prompts us to take the first step towards the consolation that is promised. That step is repentance; the turning to face the Lord that enables us to truly face ourselves as we are. Only in this openness and honesty can we truly be ready to ask forgiveness - confident that this will be granted us.

The Lord's forgiveness to us – in small things and in great – bring a consolation in the depths of our being that is beyond description. This experience of consolation, of love, enables us to live our lives as effective witnesses to Him - and in the second reading this Sunday, we find St Paul reminding us that living lives that are free from sin is the way to be ready for the joyful hope and the coming of our Saviour Jesus Christ.
