## A message from Bishop Richard on the third Sunday of Advent

This Sunday is 'Gaudete Sunday'. It takes is name from the beginning of the Entrance Antiphon of the Mass, from the St Paul's Letter to the Philippians: 'Gaudete in Domino semper'; 'Rejoice in the Lord always'. St Paul goes on to say: 'Again, I say, rejoice. Indeed the Lord is near.'

St Paul writes about this joy in the Lord in the Letter to the Thessalonians – and we hear those words in the Second Reading this weekend.

It is the nearness of the Lord that is the cause of our rejoicing and, as always in Advent, this nearness of the Lord relates to our celebration of His birth and also our expectant hope in His coming at the end of time.

This second nearness is, perhaps, rather daunting for us – perhaps we are not quite ready to rejoice! If we are to rejoice in our hope at his coming, then we must heed the voice of John the Baptist. This week, the Gospel reading is from John's Gospel and the accent is on the Baptist's call to believe in the One who is to come.

There is a third sense in which the Lord is near – for the Lord is with us always. He is closer to us than we are to ourselves and knowing that He is with us, in us, is the cause of a joy beyond imagining – a joy that is present even in the most difficult and challenging moments.

It is the joy, the gift of the spirit of the Lord, about which Isaiah speaks: good news, healing, liberty, favour from the Lord. Even in the most difficult times, the gift of faith enables us to be open to this joy. We see this throughout the history of the Church, in the lives of the martyrs.

It is this joy that cannot be taken from us, that brings us to rejoice as we await the coming of the Lord at the end of time. It is a joy that is renewed as we prepare to celebrate His birth.
