Dear brothers and sisters

The Season of Advent begins the Church's Year. It is a season that is, in a sense, a time of two parts. The first, leading to the 17th December, directs our minds and hearts to the Kingdom of God. This is a theme that has been very present during the last weeks of the Church's Year, but this Season of Advent has a different feel, as it were.

Rather than focussing on judgement, there is encouragement for us to reflect on our hope and expectation of the coming Kingdom. This is reflected, in fact, in every celebration of the Eucharist, in the prayer that follows the Our Father, with the words: "as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ."

Advent calls us to ask ourselves if we are really open to the gift of hope – hope that rests in the coming of Christ, not only in our celebration of His Birth at Christmas, but most especially in His coming again.

When we proclaim our faith in the words of the Creed, we find the words "I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come." The Christian life looks forward all the time – in hope – to the wonder of the experience of total love in the Kingdom of the Father.

It is this hope that enables us to live our Christian life, often in the face of opposition and not without sufferings and difficulties, here and now – to be Christ's people each and every day, as we await His coming.

As St Paul reminds us, in his letter to the Romans, "We are children and heirs as well: heirs of God and coheirs with Christ, sharing His suffering so as to share His glory."
