Bishop Richard reflects on the feast of Pentecost.

On Thursday we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord into Heaven. This places us in the days approaching Pentecost, the celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit on the young Church.

In Holy Week, having listened to the Passion being read on Palm Sunday, we are accustomed to walking with the Lord on His path to death and Resurrection. Now, in these days before Pentecost, I invite you to reflect on the life of Our Lady and the Apostles during these days. They are in prayer in the Upper Room, awaiting the Holy Spirit.

While we may have received the Holy Spirit in baptism and in confirmation, we must continue to pray for a renewed openness to the Holy Spirit's action in us – and these days before Pentecost present us with a wonderful opportunity for this.

Please pray for those being confirmed at this time, that their openness to the gifts of the Spirit bears fruit in their lives.

Please pray for our Diocese, for in this rapidly changing world we are called to continue the mission the Lord has given us. This will require new ways of doing things, as it were – with all in the Diocese being ready to do whatever the Lord may ask of us. There is no need for us to be fearful, for the Holy Spirit abides in the Church. We can go forward with confidence, even though the road may seem unclear at times.

May our preparation for Pentecost and our celebration of this feast bring many graces to us all, and fill us with fresh heart for the mission to which we have been called.
