Bishop Richard reflects on the Solemnity of Holy Trinity:

'Our celebration of Trinity Sunday is a powerful reminder to us all of the vocation that comes to us through baptism. In this first of the sacraments, we are baptised in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, in accordance with the Lord's command to his apostles.

We see in the three Persons of the Blessed Trinity the reality of perfect love. On this day, let us all take time to reflect on what that really means – living one's whole life caught up in the love that exists in God Himself – the love that is eternally present in One God, Three Persons.

Our whole lives are all about growing in that love, understanding it ever more deeply and allowing ourselves to be conformed to that perfect love.

This is not all – in baptism we receive a vocation. It is the call to live in this love, certainly, but it is also the call to be bearers of that love to our brothers and sisters, in every circumstance and in every place. As we live in the love of God, we belong to the Father; we follow the Son - who is the Way, the Truth and the Life - we do everything according to the promptings of the Holy Spirit and in the power that we receive in the Spirit's gifts.

We may fail often along the way, but the irresistible love of the Trinity calls us back to set out on the journey once again. May this Trinity Sunday be a day when we recommit ourselves to that baptismal journey – in the love of the Trinity, and in the service of our brothers and sisters, that is possible when we live in this love.'
