Bishop Richard reflects on the Solemnity of St John the Baptist:

On Saturday June 24th we celebrate the birth of John the Baptist. Along with the Lord Himself and Our Lady, John the Baptist is the only other person whose birth is marked in the Church's calendar. This is a way of marking his particular place in God's plan.

John is the very last of the prophets of the Old Law. He points the way to Jesus; his mother Elizabeth is the cousin of Mary. He stands alone in many respects - his lifestyle as a desert dweller, his work as a baptiser to whom so many come for the forgiveness of their sins. His remarkable life ends with his being put to death by Herod, another feast that we celebrate.

Above all else he points the way to Jesus - like no other prophet he can literally say 'there is the Lamb of God'. The one who Jesus Himself describes as having 'no equal' is marked especially by his humility, for he proclaims that his ministry is over as he sees the Lord, and recedes into the background, his work complete.

As followers of Jesus, we too stand apart in a certain sense. We must be ready to be noticed on account of our faith, even though this may bring us difficulties and ridicule. Like John we point the way to Christ, to be as it were, windows through which the Lord can be seen. The Christian life opens the way for us, to the life of grace, but it is only that we may be at one with the Lord in our every action, that He may be seen.
