Bishop Richard reflects on this Sunday's Readings at Mass:

Dear brothers and sisters,

The hymn with which St Paul begins his letter to the Philippians is, like any hymn that we sing, easy to commit to memory. Its brevity does not hide the fact that it is a beautiful summary of Jesus' work of salvation.

Jesus' death on the Cross brings forgiveness for our sins and leads to the Resurrection that is our life. We do well to reflect on the immensity of the gift of forgiveness. For the one who truly repents, the burden of sins is gone. The load that we carry in life is left behind and we can, in the words of St Benedict, 'run in the way of the Lord's commands.'

Forgiveness is not only for us as individuals. When we celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we do so in the context of the Church, which is His Body. The Christian community must be a community of forgiveness. Our experience of forgiveness must, surely, overflow into our family lives, our schools, parishes, and places of work. We must be seen by the world as a people of forgiveness. When we truly become such a people, we witness to Christ in a most powerful way. This is, surely, one of the most effective manifestations of the mission to which we are called.

As we grow in our understanding of the Lord's ways for us, His call to us, His forgiving love for us, let us be witnesses of His gifts to our brothers and sisters.
