Bishop Richard reflects on this Sunday's Mass Readings:

The two-fold commandments given by the Lord in this Sunday's Gospel sum up the way of life to which we are called. First - the love of God with every fibre of our being. Second - the outpouring of that relationship amongst all around us. We can remember in this context the parable of the Good Samaritan, which is a response to the question to Jesus: 'Who is my neighbour?'. The parable gives the example of the kindness of a foreigner so there are really no bounds to the definition of 'neighbour.'

The call to holiness, which is the subject of the third chapter of *Lumen Gentium* - the Constitution on the Church coming from the Second Vatican Council - is the highest calling for the human person. There is no greater activity for us than the praise of God, the love of God, our relationship with God - the relationship of love that God has for us all. Indeed, our human relationships should be mirrors of that love of God for us.

At a time when the world is torn apart in so many places, and when we experience so much injustice all around us, near and far, let us open our minds and hearts once again to the love of the Father for us - seen in the death and resurrection of His Son and in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit - that our lives may be channels of that love to our brother and sisters.
